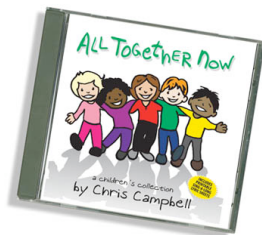

New Original Songs!

Thought we decided to not record a new quartet CD this year, we are still moving forward with writing new material for our next project. There are 2 new songs featured in our concerts that we wanted to share with you:

- **“Let Go Let God”** – This is a simple song with a very powerful message. “When life’s a highway, traveled alone, there’s a map that will take you home. So no matter what steps you’ve trod, turn it over, let go let God.” This song is the only song the four of us have ever written together.
- **“I Wanna Go Home”** – This is a special song that Chris penned to capture his appreciation for growing up in the Shenandoah Valley of VA. “Oh, I wanna go home, so take me to the Valley in the morning. In nowhere old Virginia, in a town where I learned all I need to know. Hey I wanna go home.” This is one that really pulls on our heart strings every time we perform it.

All Together Now (2011) – This is Chris’ first solo CD and it is a collection for kids. Originally intended as a gift to his young children, this project is comprised of songs designed to sing along with, to dance to, to educate, to express feelings, and to teach life lessons. Further, while the collection includes some of Chris’ all-time favorite children songs, it also includes originals stemming from his day-to-day experiences.

Traditions (2010) – We promise you, this is the ultimate Coachmen “roots” CD! This is a collection of our favorite old hymns and gospel songs, and we also included 2 bonus songs which are favorites from our live program, specifically our version of the Mac Davis classic “I Believe in Music”, and the comical Noah’s Ark translation “Didn’t It Rain.”

The Coachmen - Live in Concert (2008) - This 15-song live concert DVD video, complete with original material, jokes, and personal stories, was recorded at Clifford Baptist Church in Amherst, VA. This special package also includes an audio CD that contains 11 songs from the live concert. The church is a favorite of ours and provided the perfect setting for our first live concert video. It follows our typical Americana gospel format, along with a brief Christmas segment.

Christmas with the Coachmen (2007) – After years of requests, we released a Christmas project in 2007 comprised of many of our sacred and secular holiday favorites. This CD is reminiscent of our live Christmas shows and was recorded as a live set. From “Let It Snow” to “Do You Hear What I Hear” to “Til’ the Season Comes ‘Round Again”, the collection includes something for everyone.

Arise (2007) – Our third compilation, considered by many critics our most original and diverse to-date. Popular original songs include Chris Campbell’s ‘Arise’ and Bob Campbell’s ‘Sandlot Hero’, in addition to covers of ‘He Walked on Water’, ‘Wonderful Time Up There’, ‘Oh Shenandoah’, and ‘Everyday Will Be Sunday’.

Going Home (2005) – Our sophomore recording effort, which shows a more advanced Coachmen in terms of vocal, musical, and songwriting styles. Popular original songs include Bob Campbell’s ‘Three Roses’ and Chris Campbell’s ‘When the Eagle Flies’, in addition to covers of ‘Long Black Train’, ‘Love Can Build a Bridge’, ‘Back Home Again’, ‘Thanks to Calvary’, and ‘God on the Mountain.’

This Old House (2004) – This is our first CD as an Americana Gospel group. Popular original songs include Chris Campbell’s ‘I Pledge My Allegiance to the Cross’ and Bob Campbell’s ‘Home Sweet Home Virginia’, in addition to covers of ‘This Old House’, ‘The Baptism of Jesse Taylor’, ‘The Fourth Man’, and ‘Sweet Beulah Land.’
